

**CIMIS **

The California Irrigation Management Information System (CIMIS) is a program unit in the Water Use and Efficiency Branch, Division of Statewide Integrated Water Management, California Department of Water Resources (DWR) that manages a network of over 145 automated weather stations in California. CIMIS was developed in 1982 by DWR and the University of California, Davis (UC Davis). It was designed to assist irrigators in managing their water resources more efficiently. Let your faucets drip overnight or when you are not home if the temperature is expected to be well below freezing. This might seem like a waste of water but it will actually help prevent your pipes from freezing and bursting, which will be a lot more expensive then a dripping faucet.

~CCCSD ~ Reminders ~

- ** The office is closed between 12:00pm—1:00pm to allow our employees to have a non-interrupted lunch hour.
- ** You can pay your water bill on line at clearcreekcsd.org by using your book # and account # and the last four digits of the phone number you have on file with us. The online banking system does charge a fee of \$3.95 per transaction though and this has NOTHING to do with CCCSD. If you have questions about how to log in or your account information, please call the office.
- ** There is a 3% convenience fee from the bank when using a bank/credit card to pay your bill.
- ** Please DO NOT turn on and off your own meter. If you have a leak and don't have your own downstream valve to turn your own water off, please call the office, 24hrs a day, someone is available to come assist you.
- ** All bills are due by the 20th every month (even if it lands on a weekend). Remember that our mail system is very delayed these days, so you may ask your bank to issue us a check by the 20th and they aren't always making it here by then. Penalties of 1.5% are charged to all accounts with a balance at 12:00pm on the 21st, giving you some leeway with getting payment in here.
