# Happy New Year What's New:

The Board had a good meeting in December to initiate a "Drought and Supplemental water" program to be used when ever the District is back in a drought. All the early projections are that we will have a normal / average to above average rainfall this winter – so there is hope we will not be in a drought in 2024.

The deadline for applications for community members on the three standing committees has been extended to mid-January – If interested check the District website: Committees tab for a <u>description of each committee and an application</u>.

The District started flushing the system early in November, continued in December and we plan to finish in January. After years of drought, we are reinstituting this as a semi-annual system maintenance activity that benefits the system by getting proper operation of hydrants, removing sediment and mineral buildup in the water mains to help deliver clean safe water to all.

**General Manager Note:** Update on District Grants: The Board in December awarded the bid on The Backwash Ponds project to the lowest responsible bidder for construction starting mid-2024.

District modernization efforts continue – the So. Booster/Wells project is scheduled to finish this month and is for increased electronic communication and controls in our wells field and booster station. The new customer billing system is going through extensive testing with plans to go live in February.

Update/Education Section: In this section I went through explanations of all our fees and how they were developed and used for. Check previous newsletters. Now covering some budgetary and cost items.

The District pays for an answering service, and much of the cost is based on "calls received". If there is an emergency, do not hesitate to call. For non-emergency calls, call during business hours: M – F: 8am to 5pm: Closed for lunch noon – 1pm. Closed weekends and Holidays.

#### <u>Full Water Allocation – Rates Report:</u>

Reminder: The Base rate is \$57.11 plus water usage and fees. Make sure to pay on time - A Late Fee of 1.5% will be applied to accounts who have not paid their bill by the 20th of each month. The District sent hundreds of delinquents and shut off notices (60 days plus late in payments) — with hundreds making payments or getting payment assistance. If you need payment assistance - Programs are available. Call or email the office to find out more.
