Full Water Allocation for 2023

The Bureau provided an updated allocation to the District for our 2023/24 water year in the amount of 100% of the District's contract, ending the drought. All customers can use as much water as they can afford throughout 2023 and into 2024.

Based on improved water conditions the Bureau's allocation is now a "normal year" for the District. The Bureau's area manager attended the May 17th meeting and reported that there is some hope that a regular weather year this winter could return Shasta to full for next year and we could have multiple non-drought years. The Bureau also answered questions from the board, reported on plans and Trinity Lake levels.

We have been dealing with some recent leaks - large and small. Please be patient as we work through fixing them and then cleaning up. This reminds the District that all customers should check their pressure <u>release valves at their property</u> to handle the restoration of service after a leak repair.

General Manager Note: The Board has been very active updating the long list of Policies of the District. Once updated, we plan to consolidate into one easily accessible document. We are also developing the District Budget for 2023-24 and getting as accurate on revenues and expenses and finding places to put money back into reserves and for projects to update our infrastructure. We are busy implementing and looking for grants to help us rebuild our old pipes, infrastructure and update the Treatment plant. This summer we are implementing a grant for updated electrical repairs for our South Booster and Wells.

Full Water Allocation – Rates report:

The **Board** adopted ordinance **2023-06** rescinding all water use restrictions - this ends the drought in Happy Valley! This also removes the "drought rate", and as per the Prop 218 approved (in 2021) rate structure, returns all rates to a Domestic (M&I) of \$0.72/HCF and Ag (irrigation) rate of \$0.71/HCF, these usage rates are total of the cost of water at treatment plant plus the treatment costs. Your bill will have the usage plus the Base Rate. A **Late Fee** of **1.5%** will be applied to accounts who have not paid their bill by **20th of each month**.
