

If you haven't already done so, check out the new CCCSD web site recently put on-line. The new site offers easier navigation, customer service and feedback, resources and forms available on-line, recent news, updates and notices and the FAQ page with the most common frequently asked questions. This new web site also allows for customers to sign up for alerts via email and text so when an event occurs and requires immediate notification you can be notified via an email address or through your cell phone via a text.

Our customers can also access the real time weather station, the latest Happy Valley Farm Trail map, a conven-

ient drip calculator and the current reservoir conditions throughout the State among other interesting links. Soon to come you will have the availability to check your account status on-line and your historical water use by establishing an on-line account (at no charge) that will only require your book, account number and pin number to access this information. You can create your own pin or allow the system to generate a random number for you.

***CIMIS ***

The California Irrigation Management Information System (CIMIS) is a program unit in the Water Use and Efficiency Branch, Division of Statewide Integrated Water Management, California Department of Water Resources (DWR) that manages a network of over 145 automated weather stations in California. CIMIS was developed in 1982 by DWR and the University of California, Davis (UC Davis). It was designed to assist irrigators in managing their water resources more efficiently. Efficient use of water resources benefits Californians by saving water, energy, and money. Visit the website @
