Fall into Water Savings: Seasonal Tips for November!

Take the Leak Challenge

Cold weather can worsen small leaks, and they waste more water than you might think. Before winter sets in take a quick household water check:

- Put a few drops of food coloring in your toilet tank and wait 15-20 minutes without flushing; if color appears in the bowl, you have a silent leak.
- Check faucets, showerheads and hose connections for drips.
- Water Meter Test;
 - Turn off all sources of water
 - Check your meter – if the meter is moving you have a leak
 - For a slow leak, note the meter reading and recheck in a few hours. If the reading has changed a leak is likely.

Smart Landscaping for the Season

Fall is the ideal time to plant native, drought-tolerant plants that will establish roots during the cool, wet months ahead. Native plants not only thrive with minimal irrigation but also support local pollinators and reduce maintenance needs. Visit a local nursery or the California Native Plant Society website for inspiration and guidance.

Preparing for Rain

When fall storms roll in, make sure your property is ready to capture every drop.

- Clean your gutters and downspouts so rainwater flows freely.
- Redirect runoff away from paved areas and toward gardens or permeable surfaces.
- If you can, consider installing a rain barrel to collect water for future landscape use.

Every drop counts – even in the rainy season!
